SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER AND ORDER
DENYING REHEARING

Petitions for a rehearing of Decision No. 25891 having been filed by protestants and by Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc., and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first paragraph of the order in said decision is amended to read as follows:

"THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Alfred R. Kelly, Jr. of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of all classes of freight between San Francisco, Petaluma, Santa Rosa and Willits, on the one hand, and Garberville and intermediate points of Laytonville, Cummings, Piercey, Hartsook and Benbow, on the other hand."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the petitions for rehearing are hereby denied.
