O R D E R

Application having been filed by Diamond Ridge Water Company, a corporation, asking for authority to transfer to N.H. Bath and J.M. Nicol, for the sum of three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600), the company's American Reservoir Site containing 107.5 acres, more or less, and situate, lying and being in the vicinity of the Town of Clarksville, in the County of El Dorado, as is more particularly set forth and described in the application herein, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Diamond Ridge Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to N.H. Bath and J.M. Nicol, for the sum of three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600), its American Reservoir Site containing 107.5 acres, more or less, and situate, lying and being in the vicinity of the Town of Clarksville, in the County of El Dorado, as is more particularly set forth and described in the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of August, 1933, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Diamond Ridge Water Company, a corporation, within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which said Diamond Ridge Water Company, a corporation, actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
