FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, filed its Fifth Supplemental Application in the above entitled proceeding with the Commission on the 25th day of May, 1933, asking to be relieved from the necessity of maintaining crossing signs, as prescribed in General Order No. 75-A, at the following grade crossings in the City of San Gabriel, County of Los Angeles, California:

Crossing No. 6D-10.72 - Santa Anita Street
Crossing No. 6D-10.92 - San Marino Avenue
Crossing No. 6D-11.09 - Del Mar Avenue
Crossing No. 6DA-11.47- South roadway Las Tunas Drive.

Applicant alleges that since Application No. 13845 was filed and Decision No. 19263 rendered January 20, 1928, the private right of way of Pacific Electric Railway Company between the two roadways of Las Tunas Drive between Mission Road and San Gabriel Boulevard was paved in, making Las Tunas Drive a wide paved street; that the above crossings are in this area and are in the residential section of the City of San Gabriel; that the City of San Gabriel objects to the appearance of signs, and that the No. 1 signs which were installed at said crossings have been removed by the City or its employees, as applicant has been informed, without advising applicant.

A report of the Commission's representative shows that boulevard stop signs have been established at three of the four crossings involved herein and that a wigwag is maintained at the fourth (No. 6DA-11.47). It appears that a public hearing is not necessary and that this request should

be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to eliminate crossing signs at the grade crossings hereinbefore described, as prescribed in the Commission's General Order No. 75-A.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
