

Decision No. 25590

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of
CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY,
a corporation:

(1) For authority to abandon rights,
if any, under Ordinance No. 364 (N.S.)
of the County of Los Angeles, as to a
part of the franchise area therein
described, upon obtaining a new fran-
chise covering such part of said area;
and

(2) For an order of the Commission
declaring that, after said new fran-
chise is obtained, it will issue a
certificate of public convenience and
necessity authorizing applicant to
exercise the rights and privileges
granted thereunder.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission having issued its Decision No. 25590 on the thirtieth day of January, 1933, in the above entitled proceeding, wherein it was provided that a supplemental order would be issued granting California Water Service Company, a corporation, a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of a waterworks in a tract of land adjoining the City of Redondo Beach in the County of Los Angeles upon the condition that applicant obtain a new franchise from said county covering the said tract, and applicant having obtained said franchise which is designated as Ordinance No. 2280 (N.S.) of the County of Los Angeles and having filed same with this Commission, now, therefore,

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require that California Water Service Company, a corporation, exercise the rights and privileges granted to it by Ordinance No. 2280 (N.S.) of the County of Los Angeles in the operation of a public utility water system supplying residents in the territory as more particularly described in said Ordinance, provided applicant herein file with this Commission, within twenty (20) days from the date of this Order, a resolution duly passed and approved by its Board of Directors to the effect that said applicant, its successors or assigns will never claim for said franchise a value in excess of the actual cost of securing same.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
