FURTHER ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF SERVICE

Applicant E. N. Cuneo, having been authorized by Decision No. 25512 and Decision No. 25846 to suspend until April 1, 1933 and thence to July 1, 1933 respectively, all passenger and freight operations between Jackson and Ranger Station as authorized by Decision No. 15933, dated February 6, 1926 on Application No. 12473 and Decision No. 18100, dated March 21, 1927 on Application No. 12886 and applicant having made written request for further suspension until October 1, 1933, and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E. N. Cuneo be and he is hereby authorized to continue suspension authorized by Decision No. 25512 and Decision No. 25846 until October 1, 1933, provided applicant shall immediately file in duplicate, suspension of time schedules and, in triplicate cancellation of tariffs, within fifteen (15) days from date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, should public con-

venience and necessity require service within the suspension period herein designated, applicant E. N. Cuneo will immediately resume operations.
