O R D E R

Application having been filed by the City of Redwood City and concurred in by the Emerald Lake Water Company in a supplemental application, for authority from this Commission to transfer the water works owned and operated by the Emerald Lake Water Company, a corporation, in and near the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, California, to the City of Redwood City, a Municipal Corporation, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request of the applicants should be granted, now, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Emerald Lake Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, California, a Municipal Corporation, the water works owned and operated by it in and near the City of Redwood City, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of September, 1933, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by the Emerald Lake Water Company within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

- (2) Within ten (10) days from the date on which said Emerald Lake Water Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
- (3) Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order said Emerald Lake Water Company shall refund to all of its consumers all amounts, if any, due such consumers arising from deposits made to guarantee payment of water bills, or for main extensions, meter and/or service connections, and/or any other purpose whatsoever.
- (4) On or before the first day of November, 1933, said Emerald Lake Water Company shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating that it has duly complied with paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of the Order herein.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
