ORDER AMENDING ORDER

By Decision No. 25506, dated December 31, 1932, Jos. Barrere, Inc. was authorized to suspend service as a carrier of milk, etc. between Gustine and Los Banos until July 1, 1933. By this supplemental application applicant requests suspension of such operating right until further order of the Commission, with the privilege of operating "on call" service as may be demanded, without schedule; and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jos. Barrere, Inc. be and it hereby is authorized to suspend, until further order of this Commission, or until applicant elects to restore same, scheduled service between Gustine and Los Banos and intermediate points (not including Gustine), and to reduce same to service on demand only.
