

Decision No. 26227.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of MT. SHASTA POWER CORPORATION, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and the McCLOUD RIVER LUMBER COMPANY, a corporation.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By its Decision No. 19279 dated January 23, 1928, the Commission approved a certain agreement dated December 10, 1927, made and entered into by and between Mt. Shasta Power Corporation and McCloud River Lumber Company covering the sale and purchase of electric energy over a period of ten (10) years from and after the date of completion by Mt. Shasta Power Corporation of certain facilities referred to in said agreement.

Under date of March 29, 1933, said parties entered into a further agreement, amending said agreement of December 10, 1927, extending the term of the latter agreement for a further period of one (1) year, namely until November 9, 1933, and agreeing that, inasmuch as McCloud River Lumber Company had of necessity to discontinue its lumber operations for a period of one (1) year from December 10, 1932, all electric energy sold to said consumer during said year beginning with December 10, 1932, shall be billed under Schedule L-3, provided that if McCloud River Lumber Company shall at any time during said year use energy for its

Lumber operations, then said consumer shall pay for the first two thousand (2,000) kilowatt-hours per month under Schedule I-3 and the balance under Schedule P-1.

The Commission being of the opinion that this amending agreement should be approved,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said agreement, dated March 29, 1933, between Mt. Shasta Power Corporation and McCloud River Lumber Company be and it is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective upon the date hereof.
