O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, having filed the above entitled application with the Railroad Commission requesting approval of a certain agreement dated June 19, 1933, entered into by and between applicant and E.M. Hamilton, F.A. Beauchamp and S.E. Woodworth, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of "Central Tailings Company" and engaged in mining operations in Amador County, substantially in accordance with the words and figures as set forth in the form therefor marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein and entered into by and between the above-mentioned parties, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery of water for mining purposes to said Central Tailings Company for a five-year period from and after the date water shall first be delivered, said water to be delivered by the Pacific Gas and

Electric Company from its Amador Canal into the pipe line of the South Eureka Mining Company as agreed upon by and between the users of the water and the said South Eureka Mining Company, in quantities not in excess of thirty (30) miner's inches per day or less than three (3) miner's inches per day at a rate of twenty cents (20¢) per miner's inch per day (a miner's inch being equivalent to one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) cubic feet of water per minute, measured through any orifice), and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreement entered into by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and E.M. Hamilton, F.A. Beauchamp and S.E. Woodworth, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of "Central Tailings Company," under date of June 19, 1933, a copy of which is attached to the application herein and marked Exhibit "A", be and it is hereby approved.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
