OPINION

Feather River Stage Co., a corporation, by D. J. Martin, its President, has made application to discontinue all service for the transportation of persons and property between Oroville and Quincy and intermediate points, and revoking said operating right. The right was created in applicant by Decision No. 24921, dated June 27, 1932, on Application No. 18032, and is part of the consolidated rights of the corporation.

Applicant alleges that the out of pocket cost of operation this year has been \$255.65, while the ten passengers transported, together with property, provided a revenue of \$88.50, an operating deficit of \$167.15.

This is a matter in which a public hearing does not appear necessary. The application will be granted, subject to the usual conditions.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Feather River Stage Co., a corporation, operating as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and property between Oroville and Quincy, under authority of Decision No. 24921, on Application No. 18032, be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue all service and abandon said operative right, provided applicant shall post notices in its vehicles and at its terminals at least five (5) days before the effective date of such discontinuance and abandonment, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that that portion of said Decision No. 24921, granting such rights between Oroville and Quincy and intermediate points, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
