ORDER REVOKING ORDER

WHEREAS, changes of train service by Southern Pacific Company at Rand Station and Searles necessitates delivery of passengers and property to connecting carriers at Searles instead of Rand Station; and

WHEREAS, by Decision No. 26021, dated June 5, 1933, applicant was authorized to discontinue all service between Johannesburg, Randsburg and Searles; and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 26021 herein be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and Charles A. Lindsey is authorized to resume all service between Johannesburg, Randsburg and Searles and intermediate points, provided that he shall file within fifteen (15) days from date hereof proper time schedules therefor, and tariffs to be identical with those established for such service on file with this Commission prior to December 5, 1932.
