ized to establish, within sixty (60) days from the date of this  
order and upon not less than ten (10) days' notice to this Com-  
mission and the general public, by filing and posting tariffs  
in the manner prescribed in Section 14 of the Public Utilities  
Act, the commodity freight rates between San Francisco, Oakland  
and Alameda on the one hand, and Sacramento and intermediate  
points on the other, as per Exhibit "A" and as amended, attach-  
ed to and made a part of the application."
