O R D E R

American States Water Service Company of California, a corporation, having asked permission to sell and transfer its public utility water works serving consumers in and in the vicinity of the unincorporated town of El Modena, Grange County, to R.W. Jones and M.E. Jones for the sum of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400) to be evidenced by the purchasers' promissory note payable on or before two years after date of issue with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, that this application should be granted as herein provided, and that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for through the issue of the note is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein, which purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expense or to income, now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that American States Water Service

Company of California, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to sell and transfer to R.W. Jones and M.E. Jones its public utility water works supplying consumers residing in and in the vicinity of El Modena, Orange County, such sale and transfer to be made under the terms and conditions of the agreement filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that R.W. Jones and M.E. Jones be and they are hereby authorized to execute a note in the principal amount of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400) payable on or before two years after date of issue, with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum in payment for such water works.

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:

1. Within ten (10) days from the date on which it actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, American States Water Service Company of California shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
2. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall be made on or before the first day of November, 1933.
3. Within ten (10) days after the actual transfer of the properties herein provided, the American States Water Service Company of California shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance, including the promissory note executed by R.W. Jones and M.E. Jones in the sum of two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400), as set forth in the exhibits attached to the application herein.

4. The authority herein granted to issue a promissory note will become effective when R.W. Jones and M.E. Jones have paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which fee is twenty-five dollars (\$25).

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
