OPINION

R. D. Dorris, operating passenger and freight auto-
motive transportation service between Nevada City and Forest,
under the name Dorris Stage and Freight Line, by authority
of Decision No.11433, dated December 29, 1922, on Application
No.7737, has requested authority to suspend service. Applicant
alleges that the destruction of certain bridges along his
mountain route, and generally bad road conditions along the
thirty five miles between termini make the suspension of service
necessary. According to his annual report his 1932 gross
receipts were only \$70.00 for both passengers and freight.
Applicant is restricted against serving Forest from Nevada City,
as this point has other service. The intermediate points are
not now active.

This is a matter in which a public hearing does not
appear necessary. The application will be granted, subject
to the usual conditions.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that R. D. Dorris be and he is
hereby authorized to suspend freight and passenger service
between Nevada City and Forest, as authorized by Decision
No.11433, on Application No.7737, until May 1, 1934, providing
applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance at his
terminals at least five (5) days before the effective date of

such discontinuance and shall file within thirty (30) days after date hereof withdrawal and cancellation of his time schedules and tariffs therefor.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from date hereof.
