FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second paragraph of the Order dated August 21, 1933, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendant Southern Pacific Company be and it is hereby authorized and directed to refund to complainant, with interest at six (6) per cent. per annum, all charges collected for the transportation from Los Angeles to Brawley and Calexico of the shipments of steel articles involved in this proceeding in excess of 43 and 45 cents respectively, per 100 pounds."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our order of August 21, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect.
