OPINION and ORDER

Humboldt Motor Stages, Inc. seeks authority to suspend its operations between Berti and Falk, on its line between Eureka and Falk. The suspension will eliminate six miles in each direction. Applicant alleges that this service was sustained by revenues from a contract for carrying the United States mail, which contract expired October 13, 1933. Exhibit "A", attached to the application, shows that during the months of July, August and September the receipts on this line were \$402.79 of which only \$59.05 was for passengers and express. Applicant alleges that the cost is too great to continue the service until the lumber industry at Falk improves.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Humboldt Motor Stages, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to suspend all operations between Berti and Falk, provided applicant shall post notice of such discontinuance in its vehicles now used between said points at least five (5) days before the effective date thereof and shall, within fifteen (15) days from date hereof, file suspension of its tariffs and time schedules for the operation herein sought to be abandoned.
