O R D E R

Railway Express Agency, Inc., has filed an application to close its agency at Vineburg, Sonoma County. The application recites that subsequent to the closing of the agency of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company at this point the local merchant acted as Express Agent and that because of the small amount of revenue involved, said merchant no longer desires to act as applicant's agent. Applicant further states that no other person is available to handle this business and that it is necessary to request authority to discontinue the agency at this point.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Railway Express Agency, Inc., is hereby authorized to close its agency at Vineburg, Sonoma County, provided that said station shall be maintained as a non-agency station and that applicant shall continue to handle Express shipments moving into or out of said station provided they are

received from or tendered to the Express messenger upon trains
stopping at said station.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
