Applicant further states that no other person is available to handle this business and that it is necessary to request authority to discontinue the agency at this point. It appears that this is not a metter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Railway Express Agency, Inc., is hereby authorized to close its agency at Vineburg, Sonoma County, provided that said station shall be maintained as a nonagency station and that applicant shall continue to handle Express
