FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Subject to the terms and conditions of the order in Decision No. 25926, dated May 8, 1933, the Commission authorized the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company "to lease, demise, assign and transfer, on or before January 1, 1934, its properties described in this application, to the Union Pacific Railroad Company."

The Commission has not yet fixed the effective date of its order for the reason that applicants have not filed the resolutions referred to in the order.

In a supplemental application filed on October 2, 1933, applicants report that they have determined that it is not yet practical to proceed under the authority granted by said Decision No. 25926, dated May 8, 1933, and they therefore ask the Commission to extend the time, to and including October 1, 1934, within which they may comply with said order.

The Commission has considered the request of applicants and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 25926, dated May 8, 1933, be, and the same is hereby, amended by substituting "October 1, 1934" for "January 1, 1934" in said order, and that in all other respects said order shall remain unchanged.
