O R D E R

Railway Express Agency, Inc., a corporation, filed the above entitled application on October 11, 1933, requesting authority to discontinue its agency at Emigrant Gap on the main line of Southern Pacific Company, in Placer County.

The application states that the nearest agency stations on each side of Emigrant Gap are Cisco, 8.5 miles easterly, and Towle, 15 miles westerly; that during period June, July, August and September, 1933, 381 shipments producing a revenue of \$588.00 were handled at this point; that the major portion of the express traffic originates through the operation of a lumber mill at this point and that said operations will be suspended about November 1st; and that, if conditions in the spring warrant, applicant will restore the agency service.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Railway Express Agency, Inc., is hereby authorized to discontinue its agency at Emigrant Gap,

Placer County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly, provided that applicant shall continue to maintain said station as a non-agency station and to handle express shipments moving into and out of said point, provided they are received from or delivered to the express messenger at the car door of trains stopping at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
