OPINION AND ORDER

ORIGINAL

In this application the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of the warehouse business and equipment located at Livingston, California heretofore operated by C. H. Patteson also known as Howard Patteson to A. A. Austerland.

The consideration to be paid in cash for the warehouse business and equipment is the sum of seventy one and 65/100 dollars (\$71.65) which amount is said to represent the value of the equipment only, no value being assigned to the operative right.

A. A. Austerland will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 6-A, C.R.C. No. 46. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted subject to the following conditions:

1. C. H. Pattenon and A. A. Austerland shall forthwith join in common supplement to the tariff now on file with the Railroad Commission in name of California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 6-A, C.R.C. No. 48, supplements thereto or reissue thereof, applicant C. H. Pattenon on the one hand withdrawing and applicant A. A. Austerland on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariff and all effective supplements thereto.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
