OPINION ORIGINAL

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests authority to reroute
its service between North Hayward and Dublin via reconstructed
Dublin Canyon Highway and for authority to abandon service at
Canyon Inn and to withdraw the ~~tariff point~~. The
State highway between termini has been reconstructed in a more
direct and safer route. The patronage from Canyon Inn fare
points, where no agency is maintained, has approximated fifteen (15)
passengers per month and the new highway is not inconveniently at
a distance from the old point.

This is a matter in which a public hearing appears
unnecessary. The application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc.
be and it is hereby authorized to reroute its service between
North Hayward and Dublin over the newly constructed State highway.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant be and it is
hereby authorized to withdraw and cancel tariff point at Canyon
Inn and to abandon service over the old highway between termini
named, provided applicant shall post notice of such abandonment
at Canyon Inn at least five (5) days before the effective date
