OPINION and ORDER

**ORIGINAL**

Rudolph Wuescher, operating an auto stage service as a common carrier of passengers and property between Willits and Hearst, under authority of Decision No. 22687, on Application No. 16695, has made application for a suspension of all service from October 15, 1933, to July 1, 1934. He alleges such meager patronage that the service is operated at a loss. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority is hereby granted to Rudolph Wuescher to suspend all service between Willits and Hearst, as authorized by Decision No. 22687, until July 1, 1934, provided applicant shall, within twenty (20) days from date hereof file supplement to his tariff and time table with the Commission covering the suspension of service herein authorized.
