SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

ORIGINAL

In Decision No. 26243, dated August 14, 1933, in the above-entitled application, Pacific Electric Railway Company and Los Angeles Railway Corporation, operating under the name of Los Angeles Motor Coach Company, were granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate motor coach service in the City of Beverly Hills. Said Second Supplemental Application stated that applicants proposed to establish such service for a period of sixty (60) days, at the end of which time they would notify the Commission if they desired to continue the service. On October 25, 1933, applicants wrote the Commission that said line will have been operated for a sixty-day period on October 31, 1933, and that the revenues from said operation do not justify its continuance. It is alleged that said operation resulted in a net loss of \$.116 per coach mile. The Board of Directors of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce has given its approval to the discontinuance of this service. It appears that this is not a matter in which public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company and Los Angeles Railway Corporation are hereby authorized

to discontinue operation of that certain motor coach line, certificate for which was heretofore granted in Decision No. 26243, in the above-entitled application, and to cancel all rate tariffs and schedules pertaining thereto.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the passenger service herein authorized.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.
