ORDER TO REROUTE SERVICE

Applicant seeks authority to route its auto stage between Bakersfield and Oil Junction in order to benefit by the new state highway to the west of the Southern Pacific tracks and its undergrade and overhead crossing of the rail lines. These improvements are about ready for public use. No fare points are involved. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. be and it hereby is authorized to reroute its auto stage service between Bakersfield and Oil Junction over the new state highway and to abandon its route on the east side of the Southern Pacific tracks, provided, that in no other respect shall the routings provided by Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, and supplementary orders, be altered or amended.
