FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which defendant Southern Pacific Company is ordered to cease and desist and thereafter abstain from demanding or collecting rates for the transportation of plaster and its products from Long Beach (1) to all points within the switching limits of Los Angeles; (2) to points between Los Angeles and Alhambra inclusive on its line east of Los Angeles, and (3) between Los Angeles and Burbank inclusive on the line north of Los Angeles in excess of those therein found lawful, be and it is hereby extended to December 15, 1933.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our Decision No. 25781 of March 27, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect.
