BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

The applicant herein is an interstate carrier of passengers by motor bus. Its existing operations are between San Francisco, California, and Salt Lake City, Utah, and between San Francisco, California, and Portland, Oregon, both routes being via Davis and Sacramento, California. It proposes to extend these lines from Davis and Sacramento to Los Angeles, California, via Stockton, Fresno and Bakersfield.

The application is made for this Commission's approval of the proposed extension in conformity with a provision of the Code of Fair Competition for the Motor Bus Industry adopted under the National Recovery Act, which provides that a certificate of convenience and necessity or permit issued by each state through which any motor bus operator shall extend his operations after October 31, 1933, shall be obtained and filed

with the Motor Bus Code Authority.

Applicant proposes to transport only interstate passengers. This Commission is without jurisdiction to grant a certificate of public convenience and necessity for such an operation. It appears, however, that in so far as this Commission is empowered to give its authorization or permit for the transportation of passengers as proposed, the application should be granted, subject, however, to applicant's compliance with the provisions of this Commission's General Order No. 90 requiring a registration certificate for each bus to be operated in such service.

O R D E R

The Commission being of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a public hearing, and it appearing that the application herein should be granted in so far as the Commission may have authority so to do, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permit be and is hereby granted to Victory Bus Line, Inc. to operate motor buses for the transportation of interstate passengers only, together with their baggage and express, between Davis and Sacramento, California, and Los Angeles, California, via Stockton, Fresno and Bakersfield, said operation to be in connection with and as a part of the existing interstate operation of motor buses by the Victory Bus Line, Inc. between San Francisco, Davis and Sacramento, California, and points in other states.

It is a condition of this permit that the grantee comply with the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 90

requiring a registration certificate for each motor vehicle
so operated in interstate commerce upon the highways of this
state.
