

Decision No. 26612.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC
ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY for permission to
reduce its passenger service to one trip in
each direction daily in the territory from
Santa Fe Springs, in the County of Los
Angeles, to Fullerton and Stern, in the
County of Orange, California.

THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 22668, in the above entitled application, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized to reduce its passenger service between Los Angeles and Fullerton, Yorba Linda and Stern, and in carrying out said reduction in passenger service, under schedules which were made effective on August 1, 1930, it appears that all service was discontinued between Yorba Linda and Stern, a distance of 1.45 miles, although such discontinuance was not authorized in the decision referred to above or in any subsequent decision in this application.

Applicant now requests that formal authority for this discontinuance be given, as a matter of record, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that this request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby granted authority to discontinue all passenger service on its La Habra-Fullerton Line between Yorba Linda and Stern, Orange County.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
