Protestants presented witnesses who testified that applicant
has been engaged in the selling of tickets and in transportation
activities which are not in accordance with the law or the rules
and regulations of this Commission. From the evidence in this
proceeding, it would appear that the applicant is not a fit and
proper person to be granted a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent's
License. The application should be denied.
