OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application of Great Western Power Company of California, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement dated October 26, 1933, made and entered into by and between applicant and East Contra Costa Irrigation District. A copy of this agreement, marked Exhibit "A," is attached to and made a part of the application.

Under the terms and conditions and during the term specified in the aforesaid agreement, applicant has agreed to sell and deliver to East Contra Costa Irrigation District and the latter has agreed to purchase from the former all of the electric energy which said East Contra Costa Irrigation District shall require for the operation of its electrical machinery and apparatus and in the conduct of its business upon its premises situate near Brentwood in the County of Contra Costa, State of California, it being provided in said agreement that the same shall become effective as soon as, but not before, it shall have been approved by the Railroad Com-

mission; that said agreement of October 26, 1933, shall continue in force and effect until the expiration of the term of seven (7) years from and after the first day of January, 1933, and thereafter until terminated in the manner provided in said agreement. Under said agreement of October 26, 1933, the charges to be paid to applicant by East Contra Costa Irrigation District for three (3) phase, sixty (60) cycle alternating current electric energy at twenty-two thousand (22,000) volts shall be in accordance with the charges hereinafter set forth, viz:

Fixed Charges of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) per year, payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments, plus an

Energy Charge of three mills (\$.003) per kilowatt-hour per month.

The consumer agrees to maintain and use the existing power factor corrective equipment or its equivalent during the term hereof.

The Commission is of the opinion that said agreement is in the interest of both parties and that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-mentioned Agreement between Great Western Power Company of California and East Contra Costa Irrigation District, dated October 26, 1933, be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
