O P I N I O N

By complaint filed November 9, 1933, the Commission was asked to suspend reduced rates on paint and paint materials from San Francisco Bay points to Sacramento, named in Item 1675, original page 65AA of Pacific Motor Transport Company's Local Express Tariff No. 9, C.R.C. No. 13, and Item 2855, Supplement 40 to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's Tariff 14815-3, C.R.C. No. 670.

On November 14, 1933, the said reduced rates were suspended pending a hearing to determine their lawfulness. By Decision No. 28830 issued today this suspension proceeding was vacated and set aside for the reasons set forth in the opinion thereof. It follows therefore that this proceeding should be dismissed.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts of record, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
