SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above
entitled proceeding and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the third paragraph of the Com-
mission's Order of November 25th, 1933, be and it is hereby changed
to read as follows:

Starting at Washington Boulevard and Vermont
Avenue in Los Angeles, north on Vermont Avenue via
Hyperion Avenue and Glendale Boulevard to theater
number one on San Fernando Road near Glendale Boule-
vard, thence north on Central Avenue to Glendale
theaters, thence across Colorado Boulevard to
Pasadena, thence south on Broadway to South Pasadena,
or vice versa.

In all other respects the Order in the above entitled
proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
