

$\underline{O P I N I O N}$

This is an application for a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent's License, filed under the provisions of Chapter 390, Statutes of 1933.

A public hearing on this application was conducted by Examiner Handford at San Francisco, the matter was duly submitted and it is now ready for decision.

Applicant has been engaged in the sale of transportation in San Francisco and has operated in the Hotel Statler and Hotel Tynan.

The record shows that witnesses have negotiated with applicant and have been offered transportation over uncertified lines from San Francisco to Southern California points. Applicant intends to sell transportation for Boyd's Dollar Lines, Nevins Lines, United Stages and for any and all motor carriers that may be authorized by the Railroad Commission to transport passengers. Applicant has heretofore, and recently, sold and has offered for sale and negotiated for the sale and transportation of passengers over unauthorized and uncertificated lines.

Applicant has been arrested and charged with the violation of state and local laws governing stage transportation.

We have carefully considered the record herein and conclude therefrom that the applicant is not a fit and proper person to whom a Motor Carriers Transportation Agent's License should be issued. The application should be denied.
