By reason of more complete information of the water used by the different classes of service on the company's system being made available, it appears that the proposed rates set out in said Decision No. 20593 and as herein corrected will effect an annual reduction in revenue of approximately twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$29,000) instead of approximately twenty-seven thousand (\$27,000) estimated in the aforesaid decision.

In all other respects said Decision No. 26593 shall remain in full force and effect.
