ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND
FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Petition for a rehearing of our Decision 26593 in
the above entitled matter having been filed by The Sweetwater
Water Corporation; the Commission having carefully considered the
said petition, and each and every allegation contained therein, and
being of the opinion that no good cause for the granting of a re-

hearing is therein made to appear,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby denied.

By reason of a typographical error occurring in the order in the above decision covering the monthly rates to be charged for fire hydrant rental and for street and road sprinkling, and good cause appearing,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that so much of the order in said decision as reads as follows:

"Fire Hydrants:

Per month, each	\$2.00
For street and road sprinkling, per 100 cubic feet15"

is hereby amended and modified to read:

"Fire Hydrants:

Per month, each	\$3.00
For street and road sprinkling, per 100 cubic feet18"

By reason of more complete information of the water used by the different classes of service on the company's system being made available, it appears that the proposed rates set out in said Decision No. 26593 and as herein corrected will effect an annual reduction in revenue of approximately twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$29,000) instead of approximately twenty-seven thousand (\$27,000) estimated in the aforesaid decision.

In all other respects said Decision No. 26593 shall remain in full force and effect.
