IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the time within which Santa Barbara Telephone Company may issue the stock authorized by Decision No. 23199, dated December 19, 1930, as amended by Decision No. 24252, dated November 23, 1931, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including December 31, 1934, provided that the proceeds from said stock when received by applicant shall be deposited in a special bank account and withdrawn only for such purposes as may hereafter be permitted by the Commission in supplemental orders.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 23199, dated December 19, 1930, as amended by Decision No. 24252, dated November 23, 1931, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Third Supplemental Order.
