OPINION and ORDER

O. C. and N. Stages, Inc. has made application to discontinue temporarily auto stage service as a common carrier of passengers and/or property between Susanville and Alturas until about April 1, 1934.

The reason assigned is the impassable condition of the unimproved highway due to winter storm conditions and the small demand for transportation. Rail service between the points is maintained during the winter except when prevented by storm conditions.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is unnecessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be and it hereby is granted to O. C. & N. Stages, Inc. to discontinue all service between Susanville and Alturas until April 1, 1934, or whenever thereafter the highway becomes safe for use, provided, applicant shall file immediately withdrawal of its time schedules and tariffs for such service, as heretofore authorized by Decision No. 23145, dated December 10, 1930, on Application No. 16872.
