## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant, The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, filed with the Commission under date of December 29, 1933, a request that the installation of flood lights as specified in Condition (5) of Decision No. 26638 dated December 11th, 1933, be deferred until such time as there is a possibility of night switching over said crossing by Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company. Said applicant alleges that Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company has no immediate plan for switching over said crossing after dark and there will be no present necessity for flood lights, but it will, however, install all necessary underground conduits, bonding and track insulation so that said flood lights may be installed when necessary without disturbing the track.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and the request should be granted, therefore IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (5) of Decision No. 26638 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(5) The Department of Public Works shall, at its sole expense, install all the necessary underground conduits, bonding and track insulation for the installation of flood lights at said crossing. Said department shall, upon notification from said railroad that it will begin night switching over said crossing, forthwith install and maintain flood lights at said crossing.

In all other respects Decision No. 26638 shall remain in full force and effect.
