THIRTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9125 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein upon approval of the Railroad Commission based upon a change in the price paid for oil in the various communities served, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that a decrease in the price of oil was made effective December 16, 1933,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease its rates for artificial gas service as set forth in Schedule G-9 which became effective July 25, 1933, so that they shall be twenty-nine (29) cents per 1000 cubic feet less than the rates set forth in Decision No. 9125 for Schedule G-8, of which the present Schedule G-9 is but a variation to meet local conditions.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and

Electric Company file with this Commission on or before January 15, 1934, the revision of its schedules as herein authorized.
