OPINION

Death Valley Transportation Company, a corporation, seeks authority to discontinue until November 1, 1934, its operations as a passenger stage company between Death Valley Junction, Furance Creek Inn and other points, and between Barstow and Baker. Applicant alleges that reduction of convenient train service and lack of patronage do not provide revenue covering operating expenses. The operations are seasonal between November 1st and April 30th and are wholly for tourist use.

This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Death Valley Transportation Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to suspend all service for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Death Valley Junction, Furnace Creek Inn and other points, as provided by Decision No.24179, on Application No.17746, and Decision No.24244, on Application No.17776, and Decision No.25364, on Application No.18506, said suspension to terminate November 1, 1934, and provided applicant file notice of such suspension at least five (5) days before the effective date thereof with this Commission.
