FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In this Second Supplemental Application of Los Angeles Railway Corporation authority is sought to make a slight change in the routing of applicant's Florence-Soto motor coach line so as to provide service to the new Los Angeles County General Hospital, located at State Street and Griffin Avenue in the City of Los Angeles.

The application shows that request has been made by the management of the Hospital for the proposed rerouting. It is also shown that the application has been approved by the Board of Public Utilities and Transportation of the City of Los Angeles.

It appears that the proposed change in route to serve the new Hospital is in the public interest and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Los Angeles Railway Corporation is granted authority to reroute a portion of its Florence-Soto motor coach line so as to provide service to the new Los Angeles County

General Hospital, and in lieu of the operation over the route described in Decision No. 26692 dated January 3, 1934 in this proceeding as follows:

"From the intersection of 67th Street and Crenshaw Boulevard, thence via Crenshaw Boulevard, Florence Avenue, Pacific Boulevard, Slauson Avenue, Soto Street, Marengo Street, Mission Road, Griffin Avenue, Main Street, Workman Street to Mission Road,"

the following route will be substituted:

From the intersection of 67th Street and Crenshaw Boulevard, thence via Crenshaw Boulevard, Florence Avenue, Pacific Boulevard, Slauson Avenue, Soto Street, Marengo Street, State Street, Zonal Avenue, Griffin Avenue to Main Street.

In all other respects said Decision No. 26692 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order will be the date hereof.
