O P I N I O N

Jess E. R. Parsons has applied to the Railroad Commission for a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent's License, as required by the provisions of Chapter 390, Statutes of 1933.

Public hearings on this application were conducted by Examiner Handford at San Francisco and Los Angeles, the matter was duly submitted and is now ready for decision.

Applicant proposes to sell transportation for the West Coast Stages, operating between San Francisco and Oregon points and testified that he has had experience in the transportation business and understands the handling of the public.

A. S. Groocox, inspector for the Board of Public Utilities and Transportation of the City of Los Angeles, testified that he knew of applicant and as to his record as a former stage operator with the Big 4 Stages. Several complaints were made to and handled by this witness and his recommendation is that the applicant should not be granted a license as applied for, as several of the complaints were not satisfactorily adjusted.

We have carefully considered the record in this proceeding and from such record conclude that the applicant is not a fit and proper person to receive a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent's License, as provided by Chapter 390, Statutes of 1933.

O R D E R

Public hearings having been held upon the above entitled application, the matter having been duly submitted, the Commission being now fully advised and basing its order on the conclusion contained in the foregoing opinion,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND that applicant, Jess E.R. Parsons is not a fit and proper person to be granted a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent's License, as required by Chapter 390, Statutes of 1933, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is denied.
