

Decision No. 26837.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application  
of San Diego Electric Railway Com-  
pany, a corporation, for permission  
to abandon its freight service, and  
cancel freight and terminal tariffs  
applicable thereto.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

San Diego Electric Railway Company, a corporation,  
on January 29, 1934, applied for authority to abandon its  
freight service and to cancel its freight and terminal tariffs.

Applicant alleges that \$643.22 of freight business  
was transacted during the twelve-month period ending December  
31, 1933; that the principal commodity handled was gasoline  
for Standard Oil Company; that shipments are few and scattered  
and that the principal shipper has other means of taking care  
of its requirements.

Standard Oil Company has signified, in writing, that  
it will not oppose the granting of the application. It appears  
that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the  
application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Diego Electric Railway  
Company be and it is hereby authorized to abandon its freight  
service and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of the Com-  
mission, its freight and terminal tariffs and freight time-tables;

subject, however, to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall give at least five (5) days' notice to the public of the abandonment of said service by posting notice at its freight office.
- (2) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days, notify the Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of freight service, as authorized herein, and of the compliance of the conditions hereof.
- (3) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
