FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first sentence of the opinion in this Commission's Decision No. 26666 dated December 18, 1933, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"By complaint filed March 9, 1933, as amended July 3, 1933, it is alleged that the charges assessed and collected on 39 carload shipments of rock screenings transported from Atlas Spur, California, to El Portal, California, during the period June 28 to July 16, 1931, inclusive, were unjust and unreasonable in violation of Section 13 of the Public Utilities Act."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 26666 of December 18, 1933, shall remain in full force and effect.
