O P I N I O N

By orders dated January 18 and February 19, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding the Commission suspended until March 20, 1934, first revised page 19 of Local Freight Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 5 of Valley Motor Lines, Inc., in so far as it purported to add to the description of groceries and grocers' supplies named therein a rating on Wine, Domestic (not including Champagne). The publication was suspended upon protest of competing common carriers alleging that it was detrimental to their interests.

Thereafter respondent informed the Commission that it desired to withdraw the suspended publication. Permission to do so was granted by the Commission, and the schedule was cancelled on March 3, 1934. The cause for suspension has therefore been removed and our orders of January 18 and February 19, 1934, should be vacated and this suspension proceeding discontinued.

O R D E R

Upon consideration of all the facts of record, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that our orders of January 18 and February 19, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding, suspending the operation of first revised page 19 of Local Freight Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 5 of Valley Motor Lines, Inc., in so far as it purports to add to the description of groceries and grocers' supplies named therein a rating on Wine, Domestic (not including Champagne), be and they are hereby vacated and set aside and this proceeding discontinued.
