IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Bear Gulch Water Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to sell, on or before June 1, 1934, to the State of California, for the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, the 0.83 of an acre of land, more or less, described in

the deed filed in this proceeding as Exhibit A, which deed said Bear Gulch Water Company may execute on or before June 1, 1934.
