OBINION

The Commission by orders in the above entitled proceeding dated January 8, 1934, and February 5, 1934, suspended until May 9, 1934, Cooler Room Warehouse Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2 of Overland Terminal Warehouse Company, filed to become effective January 9, 1934. The tariff was suspended for the reason that it antedated the effective date of the Commission's order in Decision No. 26691 of January 3, 1934, in Application No. 18877, In Re Application of Overland Terminal Warehouse Co., etc., pursuant to which it was purported to have been issued.

Py Decision No. 26870 of Merch 12, 1934, and Decision No. 26926 of April 2, 1934, in the application of Overland Terminal Werehouse Company, supra, the Commission modified its order in Decision 26691 of January 3, 1934, and denied the petitions for rehearing filed by the protestants. Respondent should therefore issue a new tariff conforming to the Commission's orders in Decisions 26691, 26870 and 26926, to be filed in lies of the suspended schedule. Upon the filing of this new tariff and the withdrawal of the suspended schedule the Commission's orders of

suspension and investigation should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued.
