BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission by order dated April 11, 1934, suspended until May 12, 1934, the operation of portions of The L-H Lines (Lerkin-Higgins Transportation Company) Local and Joint Freight Teriff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2, for the reason that it appeared that they named rates on commodities and between points not embraced in applicants' operating rights. By decisions in Application No. 18498, In Re Application of Larkin Transportation Company et al., these carriers were authorized to unify their operations in accordance with the terms of an agreement into which they had entered.

It was pursuant to the orders in this proceeding that the suspended tariff was issued.

By supplemental application filed April 17, 1934, in Application 18498, supra, the applicants seek an order of the Commission cancelling in its entirety said The L-H Lines Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2. They state that in view of the aforesaid suspension order they do not desire to consolidate their operations at this time but that under the terms of the agreement the consolidation would automatically take effect on the first day of May, 1934, if the tariff were not cancelled. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local and Joint Freight Tariff
No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2 of The L-H Lines (Larkin-Higgins Transportation
Company) be and it is hereby cancelled as of April 30, 1934, and
the suspension proceeding discontinued.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 26929 of April 9, 1934, in Application No. 18498 remain in full force and effect.
