FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the date on or before which defendant Southern Pacific Company is ordered to cease and desist and thereafter abstain from demanding or collecting rates for the transportation of plaster and its products from Long Beach (1) to all points within the switching limits of Los Angeles, (2) to points between Los Angeles and Alhambra inclusive on its line east of Los Angeles, and (3) between Los Angeles and Burbank inclusive on the line north of Los Angeles, in excess of those found lawful by Decision No. 25781 of March 27, 1933, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby extended to May 30, 1934.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 25781 of March 27, 1933, and as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
