BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 26848 of March 5, 1934, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby amended by eliminating therefrom the second and third last paragraphs and the first sentence of the last paragraph of the opinion, and substituting therefor the following:

"From the record herein it appears that the rates in question are in violation of Section 19 of the Public Utilities Act and for that reason should be cancelled."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 26848 of March 5, 1934, shall remain in full force and effect.
